Garuda Indonesia :

Tokyo (Haneda) – Denpasar (Bali) flight launch scheduled from 28 April, 2012

Garuda Indonesia Japan Branch (Located: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, Senior General Manager for Japan, Korea, China and USA : Faik Fahmi) announced the new launch plan of “Tokyo(Haneda) - Denpasar (Bali) flight” as from 28 April, 2012 【Subject to Government Approval】. Next year 2012 is the year of celebrates 50th anniversary of Garuda Indonesia’s flight operation in Japan. In August of 2011, conference between Japan and Indonesia aviation authority was held in Tokyo, framework structure of flights connecting Haneda and Indonesia during mid-night and early morning time range was agreed. With this consent, Denpasar flight had been considered and decided.

At present, Garuda Indonesia has daily flights of Tokyo (Narita) - Jakarta, Tokyo (Narita) – Denpasar (Bali), and Osaka – Denpasar (Bali) and three times a week of Nagoya – Denpasar (Bali). All flights depart from Japan around 11:00AM and arrive at Jakarta/Denpasar on 17:00PM to 18:00PM. This planned Haneda flight will be only flight can depart from Japan to Indonesia at night. Via Denpasar (Bali), it will be possible to arrive at major cities with high business demands such as Jakarta by noon.

Garuda Indonesia aims for further convenience for all travelers to Indonesia by launching Tokyo (Haneda) – Denpasar (Bali) flight.

Garuda Indonesia began its first commercial flight in 1949 and flight to Japan in 1962. At present, flights from 22 cities of 15 countries worldwide (including code-sharing flights) connect with 32 Indonesia’s major cities. (As of end of October, 2011) On Tokyo (Narita)/Osaka flights, passengers can take advantage of the “Immigration on-Board” service, which immigration official is on board for entry inspection to grant Visas. Garuda Indonesia plans to become an official member of “Sky Team” Alliance in 2013.
